Brief description

The aim of the IUT Summer Institute (Petroleum Engineering) is to involve researchers and teachers from near and far abroad countries in the scientific and educational environment of the Russian Federation, establish and develop educational, research and project cooperation between Russian researchers and their colleagues from near and far abroad countries.

The name of the program is not accidental: "petroleum horizon" (or "formation") is the rock from which oil and condensate are extracted is the rock from which oil and condensate are extracted. Thus, there is a reference to the topic of the IUT Summer Institute – "Petroleum Engineering" and it indicates the geographical context – "Siberia".

As part of the IUT Summer Institute, participants will become familiar with the peculiarities and technologies of oil and gas industry in the Tyumen Region, where up to 70% of oil and more than 90% of Russian gas are concentrated and produced. IUT faculty staff will talk about the development of oil and gas wells in Siberia, methods for oil recovery enhancement and inflow stimulation, hydrodynamic modeling, and the use of computer simulators for the oil and gas industry, maintenance and repair of oil and gas equipment.

Varied cultural program complements the educational program and introduces participants to the history and traditions of Siberia.

Participants

Petroleum Horizons of Siberia Summer Institute will host young and active teachers and researchers involved in oil and gas topics, interested in the culture of Russia and the possibility of cooperation.

Young teachers and researchers who recently defended their Ph.D. theses at IUT are also involved in the implementation of the project. This will facilitate easier contact with the project participants, create strong professional ties, which will give a synergistic effect in the future already after the project is ended.

IUT is open to the whole world, and within the framework of the project we will be glad to welcome young teachers and researchers from 9 CIS countries, East and South-East Asia, Middle East, and Africa.

Various interactive teaching methods are being actively introduced. As part of the program, participants will be shown computer simulators developed at the IUT Department of Machinery and Equipment. The purpose of the educational program is to develop and improve knowledge of machines and equipment used in the oil and gas industry, as well as to develop skills and abilities to perform standard operations and transfer skills to real work conditions

Physical Methods for Enhanced Oil Recovery and Inflow Stimulation

Review lecture on the problems of hard-to-recover reserves, where the methods of impacting the reservoir with physical fields and the results of practical research by young TIU scientists will be discussed

Internship topics complement the main program, taking into account the professional background of each of the participating partners:

Track: Oil and Gas Field Engineering (University of Tyumen)

The partner implements a master's program in this field of study with the participation of Gazprom Neft as one of the industry leaders

Track: Managing the Energy Transition (Ural Federal University)

The partner implements an international master's program "Global Energy Business", elements of which dedicated to the global energy transition are included in the educational program

Track: Laboratory Studies of Fluids and Core (Tyumen Petroleum Research Center)

The partner has its scientific and educational benchmarks and high competencies in this area. The organization is a subsidiary of Rosneft

Cultural Program

Excursions

The excursion program of the IUT Summer Institute "Petroleum Horizons of Siberia" introduces the participants to the city of Tyumen and the Tyumen Region, its rich history and culture

Guided city tour

Today Tyumen is the business center of the Tyumen Region, the first European city of Siberia, which for three years in a row has been ranked as the most comfortable for life city in Russia with a high "happiness index". The rich history, merchant spirit, warm hospitality for which Siberia is famous will leave an unforgettable experience

Tour program: Tobolsk - Pokrovskoye Village - Abalak Village

Extensive tour program along the Tobolsk Highway. This road has a long and very unusual destiny. The program includes a visit to the Memorial House of Rasputin in Pokrovskoye village. This is the birthplace of Grigory Rasputin, a controversial figure in the history of the Russian state. In Abalak the village, participants will visit a unique historical and architectural complex of the 18th century in the Baroque style, the Abalaksky Znamensky monastery, from where they will go straight to the city of Tobolsk. It was called the "Gateway of Asia", "Father of Siberian Cities". Tobolsk became the birthplace of people for whom all of Russia is famous – writers, composers, scientists

Archaeological Reserve Museum on Andreevskoye Lake

The archaeological reserve museum is located on the shore of the picturesque Andreevskoye Lake. It is a unique archaeological, ethnographic and natural complex. The territory of the museum is a collection of archaeological monuments: unfortified settlements, sites of ancient town, burial grounds and sanctuaries dating from the Stone Age to the Middle Ages, as well as samples of relict natural objects listed in the Red Book

Tour program to the town of Yalutorovsk

The Yalutorovsky Ostrog (Fortress) is one of the most popular tourist attractions in the Tyumen Region. It was reconstructed in its historical site. The Ostrog (Fortress) was created as close as possible to what existed here three and a half centuries ago. This is a true copy of the original fort, the layout of which is kept in the archives. The excursion includes a visit to a reconstructed wooden fort, a Russian hut, an underground Archaeological Gallery, where the dwelling of ancient people was recreated, an armory, a torture room and archives

Visit to the Cossack Farm in Tyumen

During the visit, participants will get acquainted with the traditions of Cossack culture in Siberia. They will see how highly the traditions of our ancestors are valued, the customs and foundations of the Cossacks are being revived. The program includes demonstration performances, rituals, competitions and games, Cossack songs and round dances and, of course, treats with Russian cuisine cooked over an open fire or in a real Russian stove

Tour to "IvaPark - Japanese garden"

The only and real Japanese garden in Siberia and the Urals, there is nothing like it for thousands of kilometers around. The guide will introduce participants to the three valleys of Iva Park: the Valley of Roses, the Valley of the Prairies, and participants will spend most of the time in the Japanese Garden, where they will learn philosophy, traditions and symbolism of the Garden

Workshops

All planned excursions will be held in an exciting, interactive format and will familiarize participants with the culture, traditions, customs, and creativity of the nationalities living in the region. Numerous workshops (creative workshops, cooking workshops, Cossack art of wielding combat weapons, etc.) will allow participants to become not just passive listeners, but active participants

Evening Of Hospitalit

As part of the project, participants, their Russian colleagues and the University staff are expected to travel to OLYMPIA IUT Recreation Camp located near the city in a pine forest. Ural Tales theatrical performance

The Ural Tales play based on the tales of the Ural folklorist Pavel Bazhov, created with the support of the Governor of the Tyumen Region and a grant from the Rosmolodezh Federal Agency for Youth Affairs. The main goal of the performance is to popularize the literary and folklore heritage of the Ural Federal District and Trans-Urals. The performance reveals the cultural code of the region in a new format and introduces the audience to theatrical art through unique light and laser forms, colorful bright projections
